Frequently Asked Ticket Questions

When can I purchase tickets?

Tickets will go on sale online on Wednesday, May 17th at 6:00AM. Tickets are on sale through midnight on Wednesday, June 14th of the performance weekend. Tickets will be sold at the door, if available.

How do I purchase the tickets?

You will purchase your tickets online from Dance Recital Ticketing, our ticketing provider. A link will be provided in an email, on our website, and Facebook page. Reserved seating only - you choose available seats from a seating chart online. Choose your tickets early and carefully; they are non-refundable.

How much do tickets cost?

\$18 Adults (13 and older) \$12 Children (12 and under) \$20 at the door, if available.

Free: (3 and under) Guests age three and under, are admitted free, but must be seated on your lap. If you would like a reserved seat for a guest age three and under, you must purchase a ticket.

When do I pay for the tickets?

You will pay with a credit card at the time of placing your ticket order. VISA, MASTERCARD, and DISCOVER are accepted. Choose carefully, there will be no refunds. Tickets are transferrable.

When will I receive the tickets?

Immediately when your order is placed, you will receive an email confirmation from Dance Recital Ticketing with a link to print your tickets. If you cannot print, please see the office staff at KBDS after you have made your purchase and we will be happy to help.

Is handicapped seating available? Yes, these limited seats are clearly labeled on the seating chart.

Do parents need a ticket? Yes, all family, friends, and guests must purchase a ticket.

Does a Parent Helper need a ticket? No

Parent Helpers have volunteered to stay backstage the entire show. Parent Helpers will be released to see their dancers from inside the theatre at the time of their performance although not seated with their party. Parents will then return to the cafeteria to meet their dancers after their performance.

Does the dancer need a ticket? No (See exceptions below)

All children, teens, and adults who are performing in the show will be backstage and do not need a ticket. Students will see the show from a backstage monitor and when possible, from the back of the theatre.

I have a dancer in Baby Ballet and/or Tap/Ballet ages 3-4, do they need a ticket? Yes: Complimentary Baby Ballet and Tap/Ballet age 3-4 dancers are seated in the audience with their parents before and after performing. You will receive an email with a code for a complimentary ticket for your little dancer to be seated with you at all times except during their performance.

I have a dancer(s) in multiple shows. Do I need to buy tickets for each show? Yes, Discounts available. We schedule our dancers with multiple numbers or siblings into one show if possible. However, your dancer(s) may be scheduled in multiple shows.

We offer the following ticket purchasing options:

- Everyone pays full price for their primary show. You are entitled to a discount for any additional show with the same or lesser number of tickets purchased. All discounted tickets are \$10 for Adults and Children.
- Parents/Guardians only may request a free *Unreserved Seating Pass*, if available. This will allow entrance for an open unreserved seat at the back of the theater for any additional show(s) once tickets have been purchased. If you want reserved seating for yourself or any family, friend, or guest at any additional show a ticket must be purchased.
