

Stage Makeup - Children Age 2-12

Dancers wear makeup on stage in order to make their faces and expressions visible to the audience. Makeup can emphasize facial features that would otherwise be washed out by stage lights.

Follow these simple steps to create a perfect, stage-ready face. The two videos below were made by Miss Becca and her daughter Kaelyn for the competition dancers, and are a great reference for those parents that have not applied makeup before.

Blush (Required)

- Pink or Rose.
- Apply blush to the apples of the cheeks.

Lipstick (Required)

- True Red
- Apply to the upper and lower lips.

Foundation (optional)

• Light shade similar to skin color.

Eye Shadow (optional)

• Complementary light colors.

Eyeliner (Optional)

• Apply a thin straight line to the upper lid.

Mascara (Optional)

• Gently sweep two coats on upper lashes.
